The WaterTalks with Anahuak was coordinated through COFEM's strong relationship with Anahuak president, Raul Macias. Raul has been a consistent advocate and partner in the work that COFEM does. This talk was a park of a Saturday morning parent workshop where both parents and children were present. Although much of the engagement stemmed from the parents and Anahuak leaders, the children were also quick to respond with clarity as to what the importance of water means for them and their knowledge of global climate change. Parents were interested to learn about how small behaviors can greatly affect water conservation and management. As a result, folks expressed interest in continuing these conversations in other community spaces they know of to continue sharing information about water sourcing, water usage and management, and their rights as renters, home-owners, and residents of Los Angeles County.
