The Newhall Farmer's Market attendees engaged in discussion at our WaterTalks booth ranged in age from approximately 9 years old to 80 years old. After a brief 1-2 minute introduction of the WaterTalks project goals and an overview of the water infrastructure of the Santa Clarita Valley, our team discussed specific concerns each resident had about the water provided at their residence as well as stormwater issues they may regularly experience.
