## Event Summary:

This event was the 6th part of a 9-part training session for WaterTalks CBOs in the Greater LA County area. It was also the second of four sessions focused on drinking water quality issues in the LA Region. The workshop centered around a panel discussion on experience and best practices, provided by two accomplished advocacy organizations working in other parts of the state: Self Help Enterprises and Community Water Center. Multiple members of the Leadership Group of CBOs have experience in advocacy around drinking water, and were an important part of the discussion.
