Description:

Findings from the GLAC Strengths & Needs Assessment were shared and discussed with community members as a way of ground-truthing the results. Information was gathered through chat box and verbal responses.

Core Questions and Responses:

- Did the water-related concerns seem accurate from the Assessment: Yes
- Did the community-related concerns seem accurate from the Assessment: Yes

Comments and Discussion:

General interest in learning more about where our water comes from and local water capture projects. Community members want to engage in tap water and public space water testing. Specific interest in learning more about gray water usage at home. An addition to drinking water quality concern: concerns about levels of chlorine used to treat water. City regulation on gray water infrastructure was also raised as a concern. Community members want to be able to give multiple uses to water at home. Community members would like to know if there are programs that support with paying for and installing faucet filters. They shared they do not trust faucet water quality and think this is a short term, accessible solution. Community members want to learn more about MWD recycling facility in Carson. Community members want to learn more about gray water infrastructure.
