TreePeople's Pacoima WaterTalk was a virtual Zoom meeting held in partnership with Los Angeles City Council District 7 - Office of Monica Rodriguez.

The meeting's attendees were mostly over the age of 18 and included Pacoima Neighborhood Council board members. The meeting's demographics included Latino, White and black residents. The primary topic of discussion was drinking water quality, water capture and groundwater replenishment. Several residents were highly concerned about localized flooding at Vaughn Charter School campuses and contaminated urban runoff.

TreePeople included a presentation and elicited feedback on other stormwater capture projects in Pacoima.
