3 TRUST South LA staffers presented WaterTalks, with certain survey-questions highlighted, and engaged in a listening session, with SODLA, a South LA grassroots organization made of monolingual Spanish-speaking, Latina women active in South LA social justice causes and organizations. There were 25 attendees besides TRUST South LA staff. The most frequent topics of discussion were the quality of tap water, the lack of maintenance by building owners over pipes and building water infrastructure, and the price of water. Other things that were mentioned were the lack of accessible green space (parks that are locked), learning to take care of our water/water infrastructure, unexpected water-shut offs related to construction, and the idea of recycling water at the state or city levels. The group was incredibly engaged in the questions we presented, and shared their opinions both on problems and possible solutions. We will follow-up with the interested participants and hope to return to the group for a longer discussion.
