Description:

We held a virtual listening session on 3/4/21 to gather input from residents and workers in Inglewood about water issues. It was promoted on social media with multiple boosted posts in the weeks leading to the event. The event was held on Zoom. Residents were given a brief overview of the WaterTalks program. They were then asked to share about 1) their communities strengths, 2) community needs and 3) water related issues. The meeting was available in both English and Spanish.

Questions / Comments:

Community strengths include green spaces, proximity to freeway, great weather, public transportation and progress in the community, though the question lingers as to who benefits. Needs and concerns include more pocket parks, park safety, homelessness, drinking water quality, aged premise plumbing and a lack of bike lanes.
