Description:

Residents were given a brief overview of the WaterTalks program. They were then asked to share about 1) their communities strengths, 2) community needs and 3) water related issues. The meeting was available in both English and Spanish.

Questions / Comments:

There were several teacher and other LAUSD staff present. Community strengths include a good sense of community. Needs and concerns include street trash and a need for more trash cans/pick up, homeless encampments, lack of green space and safe recreation for kids, overpaving and lack of tree canopy, desire for more recycled water, education around water conservation.
