



This engagement was done with 20 youth and about 20 adults. It was a hybrid experience. This Florence Firestone area has been emphasizing clean water and more agriculture as instituted in their 2019 community plan. This location is not considered a "cool school", but they have various plant species with various water needs. There was a farmer from Chicago, and we all had educational discussions. A majority have trust issues from past experience with water quality in the area. They were happy with what they learned from the educational component, mixed with the experience of Chicago and local past experience, the students and adults were able to reconnect and redefine water. Group is interested in project development and water conservation. We discussed water projects that could be done at this state school, which used to be a juvenile court in the past. The staff, students and online participants were eager to transform this space into a space for healing. They are incorporating new



green technology in their garden that creates water from the air. The WaterTalks survey link was shared to obtain more response for this area.

This group did not care to be photographed up close. The picture represents the participants reviewing the WaterTalks survey. Members stemmed from a previous meeting with the Willowbrook CAP. They were interested in preparing for future funding relative to water and agriculture. The areas the group represents are Willowbrook, Watts, Compton, Broadway/Athens and other South LA communities.

The group shared that they would like to see community projects have local hire. They expressed the desire for a focus on education and workforce development. They incorporated the farm system at Alma Farms into what the needs are considering drought



and utility costs. They were also committed to always stay aligned with their seven strategies to creating effective community change, which included enhancing skills and access to the water industry to name a few. They are listed in the photos.

Our water partner from PSRLA informed them about the drought in connection to the ground water systems they were interested to (Mickey) learn more about. They had an interest in community gardens/farms capital water projects and wanted to learn more about water capture. W reviewed current WaterTalks project sketches to provide the current framework of potential project scopes. Surveys were printed and collected to be recorded at a later time. They shared the information at an event at Magic Johnson Park later that night.

This was a large event with many politicians. The politicians did not have much to say. Every level of government with about 50 in the audience. The USDA coming to Compton is a big deal. Participants shared their Sativa water experience and how they were not comfortable when realizing the contamination of their families and agriculture. The USDA said that they can provide water for farms and had a grant recipient there from Barron Farms. We discussed the importance of the basic knowledge and the work it will take for the overall community to have access to the information for empowerment. The participants were interested in rainwater capture and building the connection between community and utilities. WCAEC shared basic WaterTalks education and talked about the possibilities. Hopefully USDA will keep their word to become an asset to the community's development, especially around water security, agriculture and farmer support along many other services they provide. About 50 percent said they would complete WaterTalks surveys.

They committed to being more active and to prepare their communities for the future.

They reviewed WaterTalks project sketches and feel that they are good, but most were not too sure how most sketches would impact communities' quality of water outside of treatment and projects like South Gate. The laity and members of the group were more concerned where LA County's Measure W is at and how they can participate.

For this meeting, we had breakout groups and reconvened to review each group's views. No pictures, just conversation as most were not too interested in being recorded or named. It was another example of how many have views, but do not want to be on record. It is very interesting and a hope to overcome the fear people have so we can get some real work done.

It is a blessing to be able to meet with these groups, but we must work harder at getting them to engage. Therefore, trust building is needed at every level.


